<p>Cloud</p> <p>GovCloud 01 – 33 agencies using 229 virtual machines</p>	<p>GovCloud 02 ‘Managed Cloud’ is being tendered to host production environment apps and databases</p> <p>GovCloud 03 ‘GCP Cloud’ is being tendered to house all platform applications and services</p>

FormsGen	Created 95 forms of 35 agencies

CMSs/GWHS	162 in production; 81 in staging environment; 203 LGUs/GOCCs/Projects
